









Publication Policy

AESOP-ACSP 2013 Congress will publish online a Book of Abstracts of the papers, posters and panels (roundtables) which are featured in the final programme. While the Congress proceedings with papers will not be published, the authors are required to submit their full papers to the Congress Secretariat in order to secure their participation as presenters.

The <u>full papers</u> are to be distributed only to the Congress participants in an electronic form, but not as a book and therefore with no copyright transfer. When submitting their paper, the authors are not asked to transfer the copyright of their paper; they retain this right and therefore can use the papers for any other publication outlet, such as journals, books or other conferences.

When submitting their full papers at the Congress' web page, the authors are required to indicate whether they give consent for their paper to be accessible in electronic form to the Congress participants. Those who *opt not to have their paper included* in the Congress protected web page are advised to bring printed copies to be distributed at the session. They should also send their papers to the track cochairs and the chairs of their particular session.

To upload the paper, please go to 'Submissions → Papers' tab on the Congress web page.

The **posters** are **NOT** to be submitted or sent to the Congress Secretariat, but to be brought along and posted in the designated poster area.

Both papers and posters are *required* to use their respective templates, which may be downloaded from the Congress web site: http://www.aesop-acspdublin2013.com.

The template for Power Point presentations is also provided, but its use is optional.

No submission (other than the original abstract) is needed from the coordinators of **panels** (roundtables).
